**These bursaries will be worth \$1000 each and they will be awarded to Hampton area students who are attending Hampton High School or other recognized secondary high schools. One of the Bursaries will be awarded to a student who is attending a non-academic post-secondary program.**

## **CRITERIA**

- 1. Financial need.**
- 2. Good scholastic standing.**
- 3. Acceptance at a recognized post-secondary educational institution.**
- 4. Residence in the Greater Hampton area.**
- 5. Demonstration of the Rotary motto 'Service above Self' in the student's interactions with their community.**

**Upon proof of formal acceptance and registration at the chosen post-secondary educational institution; the Bursary will be paid on the student's behalf directly to the institution.**

**Applications for these bursaries will be available from the Guidance office at Hampton High School and at the Guidance offices of other area high schools.**

## **SELECTION COMMITTEE**

**The selection committee will consist of a minimum of five (5) members of the staffs of the Hampton area high schools. The chairperson of the committee will be the primary guidance counselor. At least three teachers representing various departments of Hampton High School will be members of the Selection Committee. A member of the Rotary Club of Hampton will act as an advisor to the Selection Committee.**

**In the event of the receipt of applications from other area high schools, a representative from those schools will be invited to join the Selection Committee.**
